# Important Announcement for Indian nationals (including students) in the Philippines who wish to travel to India

### 3 May 2020

Indian nationals (including Indian students studying in the Philippines) who seek to return to India may kindly fill the form in the following link: <a href="https://www.eoimanila.gov.in/covid\_register/">https://www.eoimanila.gov.in/covid\_register/</a>

- 2. The **deadline** for the submission of the form is **Thursday**, **7 May 2020** by 23:59 hrs, Philippine Standard time. (**Those Indian students who had filled the earlier form need to fill the above form again.)**
- 3. It is stated that the purpose of this form is to only collect relevant data at this stage and no decision has been taken yet regarding flights to India. The Embassy will provide information in due course on the website and its social media accounts as and when a decision is taken by the Government of India in this regard.
- 4. The following points should be noted by those who wish to travel to India:
  - (a) Applicable airfare will be borne by them;
  - (b) They will undergo **14 days** mandatory quarantine on arrival in India at their own expense as per the protocols framed by the Government of India.
  - (c) They will be required to sign an Undertaking (attached below as Annexure I) and carry a copy of the same before boarding the flight.
  - (d) Incomplete forms will not be considered. Those who register will be contacted directly on their emails and cellphones and these should be filled in with care.
  - (e) Once the form is filled, there is no need of sending any further e-mail to the Embassy in this regard. You may follow the Embassy's website and social media platforms for further updates.
